2019-2021 CATALOGUE ERRATA (NO.2)

Listed below are changes and corrections to the 2020-21 Catalogue. The information provided is according to the current catalogue at the time (2019-2021). The catalogue is under review and the information will be updated once the review is complete. These changes only appear here, but not in the full PDF version of the catalogue published on the University and School of Law website.

Page 29. Admissions and Admission Criteria

“Applicants for admission to the Juris Doctor program must submit an application and meet the following requirements:

4. Have taken the Graduate Studies Admission Test (known under its Spanish acronym EXADEP). This last requirement is applicable to candidates to Juris Doctor in Spanish. Students enrolled in the J.D. in English are not required to take this exam.”

Admission Criteria: the text was revised to remove item number 4, and now reads as follows:

The criteria governing the admissions process are determined by the Academic Senate, with the approval of the President of the University.

The admission criteria will be the score on the LSAT and bachelor’s degree grade point average, all of which they are given equal weight for purposes of the admission’s formula.

Page 30. Transfers

“Transfer candidates that come from a law school accredited by the Section for Legal Education and Admission to the Bar of the American Bar Association (ABA), or from a non-accredited ABA law school for which the pertinent State has authorized taking the bar exam in its jurisdiction, and/or a law school affiliated with the American Association of Law Schools (AALS) must meet the following requirements:

6. Present the Graduate Studies Admission Test (known under its Spanish acronym EXADEP) results if the candidate studies in a law school in Puerto Rico.”

Transfers: the text was revised to remove item number 6.

Page 31. Special Admissions


Lawyers and students from other law schools interested in taking a course at the School of Law must meet the following requirements was revised to adding the following note.

Note. Graduates of the Juris Doctor Program of the School of Law of the Inter American University of Puerto Rico, interested in taking a course after obtaining the degree, must request readmission as a special student through the Registrar's office.

Page 41. Readmission

This section is revised to add **Readmission as Special Student:**

Graduates from the Inter American University of Puerto Rico School of Law Juris Doctor program, who want to take additional courses after graduation for professional improvement, must complete the application for readmission at the Registrar's office.
