It is everyone's responsibility to prevent infectious diseases such as **coronavirus, influenza, mycoplasma**, among others, which pose threats to health and coexistence.



Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.



Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.

The hand washing process includes water, soap, rubbing the palms and between the fingers thoroughly, rinsing, drying with paper towels and using that paper to turn off the tap. Use a hand sanitizer containing at least 60% alcohol, if soap and water are not available.



Avoid contact with sick people.



Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze and then throw it away.



Sanitizes objects and surfaces.

Keep anti-bacterial wipes within reach and use them to disinfect desks, counters and telephones. Keep common areas clean, especially bathrooms. We must all do our best and contribute to keeping our study and work area in good condition.

To make sure that you can stay home if you have symptoms of a severe cold, if you have a fever or feel sick, and to avoid further infection.
